I have been in touch with Serbabei and Sprague regarding the position of the windows in the verious photo's. To date we have been unable to find out who opened the window in question, and I don't think we will. Thanks also for the suggestions regarding Day's Mestimony, Paker's Dozen etc. I believe I will use some of this in my Appendix regarding this window. I hope you do not mind the repetition of this evidence, but I believe that many Canadians will find it new and interesting. Thanks again for your permission to use this work. Don't know what I'd do without you and your kind halp. Only hope I can repay you some day.

As you suggested in your letter, I am trying to make it as clear as possible the way in which the FBI, the junior members of the staff, and other's deliberately witheld evidence from the Commission, and still are to this day, especially the FBI. The withholding of evidence from the Archive's and the permanent record is deliberate and well illustrated by the Similas case alone.
