Re memo of SA ARTHUR L. MURTAGH dated 4/18/68 reflecting interview with DORA MC DONALD, SCLC, Atlanta.

On 4/18/68 Inspector SULLIVAN instructed the writer to make a contact at SCLC Headquarters in Atlanta and assure someone in the position of authority that the FBI was anxious and interested to obtain information that any of the SCLC people might have relating to the identity of the killer of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Inspector Sullivan explained that the contact should be made in such a way that SCLC would know that if they had any information, the Bureau would want them to come forward. Inspector SULLIVAN indicated that he did not feel that extensive interviews of numerous SCLC people should be made at this time.

The above contact was made and recorded in referenced memo.
