

Young Defends King Film

The television film about Martin Luther King Jr-that NBC is planning to show on Feb. 12, 13 and 14 has sparked a threat by some black leaders to boycott the network. Yesterday, NBC had a press conference and the six-hour series picked up some more support. According to U.N. Ambassador Andrew Young, "It won't stand up to a lot of people's image of history, but it's basically what happened." The film, he said, captures the "pain and humor" of the civil rights movement.
