The Garrison assassination probe took another bizarre turn last week as the National Broadcasting Co. entered the fray. In a Monday night documentary NBC paraded several witnesses before the camera, some of whom had been interrogated previously by Garrison aides. The tenor of their remarks was to cast doubt on much of the testimony forming the basis of the case against Clay L. Shaw, accused co-conspirator. Garrison denounced the telecast as distorted and misleading. Meanwhile, angered at the notoriety accorded the case by principals and news media, Criminal District Court Judge Edward A. Haggerty Jr. reiterated his threat to issue contempt citations after the case is concluded.
