Kohn said he sees a need for an organized crime unit in the district attorney's office; a need to enact a law giving the attorney general the right to supplant the district attorney subject to review by the courts; a need to reinstate the right of a judge to conduct a public hearing at his own volition, the request of a district attorney, or by the petition of 25 persons.

"Yarious persons who have made accusations against the district attorney's office have created an obligation to investi-gate, prove or disprove, at least 22 different kinds of crime defined in our Louisiana Criminal Statutes," he said. "The MCC has written three letters to Attorney General Jack P. Gremillion asking him to intervene and investigate," Kohn added. "He writes back to refuse and give reasons why he cannot supplant or supersede."
