Consistently, and contrary to the Foreman fiction, he had declined to be interviewed or photographed. I suppose his brother Jerry was. This happened 6/15. I'll be hearing from Jerry soon.

Your man's name is said to be Cunningham. Jimmie seems to think one of the interests is why he entered the guilty plea.

If this is the case, and if you have finished my book, you know what I have on this. You are welcome to it if NBC wants to use it.

And if anybody wants any backgrounding, it also is available. Neither my name nor the existence of the book need be mentioned.
