Dear Mr. Rankin:

Reference is made to my letter dated February 28, 1964, which enclosed a memoranium of the same date containing information furnished by the recent Soviet defector, Yuri Ivanovich Nosenko, whose reliability has not yet been established.

Backcood is one copy of a memorandum dated March 4, Molecular and March 3, 1964, concerning Lee Harvey Cowald. Mosenko has read a copy of the enclosed memorandum, initialed each page, and has stated he has no additional information concerning Oswald.

Reserve advised this Durcau that under no circumstances does he desire any publicity given to this information. He also advised that he is willing to testify before the President's Commission provided no publicity is given to his appearance before the Commission or to the information which he might furnish.

In the event you desire to have Nosenko appear before the Commission, it is suggested that you make arrangements with the Central Intelligence Agency, which Agency has custody of Notenko.
