This is in reply to your letter of September 22, 1988.

To the best of our knowledge the only documents among records of the Bureau Commission mentioning Newton Armstrong, Junior and Senior, are CD 7, page 108, and CD 301, page 13.

We are preparing for you a copy of page 13 of CD 301, relating to Newton Armstrong, Sr. It is our impression that the death of Newton Armstrong, Jr., does not eliminate the reason for withholding page 13 of CD 7. You can request the Federal Bureau of Investigation to review this page if you wish to do so, however. Pages 494-477 of CD 7 are withheld collectively under guidelines 2A, 2B, and 3G.
