6/30: Document 948, dealing with the manner in which Detective Carroll got a wrong

address for Oswald is in a file labelled "Secret Service Testimony of Lt. Revill

5/19/64" There is no testimony in it, only a two-paragraph report from Secret Service

Agent Forrest Sorrels to Inspector Kelley on the Carroll Matter, dated 5/19/64.

Document 999, labelled "FBI, Numerous Exhibits 5/28/64" contains only a Xeroxed

copy of a letter from J. Edgar Hoover to J. Lee Rankin of that date of "materials

which the Commission had requested of the Russian Government March 24, 1964." These

were apparently used for handwriting specimens of Lee and Marina, and in some cases

apparently could not be identified with him. In any event, these "numerous exhibits"

are not in the file.
