Thank you for the registered package, which has arrived.

* There was an error in it. What I had asked for is the original document (or a facsimile of it) from which the Ferrie statement, 205:585-6 was transcribed.

I would also appreciate the following:

Doc 87, folder 1, 145 (perhaps another page or so in it), a statement by J Lee Rankin saying there were two 30s in Tippit.

Copies of covering letters, memos, etc., on all parts of the autopsy protocol, from the hospital, to the Secret Service and from the Secret Service. This seems not to be in the file you have sent me. What I am interested in is also the original distribution of the eight original copies. In this connection, one of the documents in 4-1 that you sent me said the receipt for the pictures and X-rays executed by Roy Keltner was attached. It was not, and I'd like a copy, please.

Robert McClellan, then of FBI, was interviewed by the FBI to say if he is the man who could now identify a "crew-cut" man seen by Oswald to have been Secret Service entered the TSBD to use the phone.

File 8-1, Gerald's income taxes.

If there is a summary report on the ballistic (bullet) tests at Edgewood Arsenal, I'd like a copy of that, please.

Is document 1035 still classified? If it is, would you please tell me under which of the guidelines.
