What I have is this: two different copies of D-22; Exhibit 794 (which shows but one side, and I'd like the other slso); Exhibit 986 (as it appears on 180536); and something marked "CE 818", but is not, as that appears in Volume 17. This also is marked "D-22" in the lower right-hand corner, but is not the same as anything also I have so marked.

What I am still lacking is what I have twice asked for: the second change-of-sideras card filed for the closing of the New Orleans box, the one alluded to in his exeminations by mesley Liebeler as having been maded after waveld left New Orleans.

I would appreciate it very much if you could, expeditiously, supply me with what - lack for a complete set of all Oswald's change-of-address cards, both side, accurately identified.
