I would also like pages 467-9 of CD 206. I would like everything in the files on Jack T. Bowen or anyone who might be taken for him.

I again take this opportunity to respectfully remind you of certain unanswered previous correspondence. I think I am entitled to a meaningful response and I would hope you and the agency you head do not feel otherwise.
