
This is in reply to your letter of August 15 concerning records of the Warren Commission.

We have sent you copies of all records you request that we have been able to locate by using the available names and subjects. We will make the open records of the Commission available to you for any further searching you may wish to do yourself.

We have received the windshield of President Kennedy's car and the original autopsy papers of which you have copies from the Secret Service, but no other documents or exhibits.

Your letter and the enclosed check were left in one of the boxes of records used by your associates, Mr. Schoener and Mr. Verb, rather than being turned over personally to the staff member to whom it was addressed. This caused a delay in the processing of your microfilm order, but the film has been finished and mailed to you.
