What I have is three [Name obscured] copies of D-22; Exhibit 794 (which shows but one side, and I'd like the other side); Exhibit 906 (as it appears on [Name obscured]); and something marked "CE 816", but is not, so that appears in [Name obscured] [Name obscured] 17. This also is marked "D-22" in the lower right-hand corner, but is not the same as anything else I have so marked.

What I am still lacking is what I have twice asked for: the second change-of-address card filed for the closing of the New Orleans box, the one included to in his examinations by Wesley Licteler as having been mailed [Name obscured] [Name obscured] left New Orleans.

I would appreciate it very much if you could, expeditiously, supply me with what I look for a complete set of all Oswald's change-of-address cards both side, accurately identified.
