Dear Mr. Justice,

In examining the Oswald files I have found cards with which I have, on two different occasions been supplied. I find what I have is both incomplete and inaccurate.

What I have is three two different copies of Book Exhibit 794 (which shows but one side, and it's like the other side); Exhibit 908 (as it appears on 180534); and something marked "CG 818", but is not, as that appears in Volume 17. This also is marked "D-22" in the lower right-hand corner, but is not the same as anything else I have so marked.

What I am still lacking is what I have twice asked for: the second change-of-address card filed for the closing of the New Orleans box, the one alluded to in his examinations by Wesley Liebeler as having been mailed after Oswald left New Orleans.

I would appreciate it very much if you could, expeditiously, supply me with what I lack for a complete set of all Oswald's change-of-address cards, both sides, accurately identified.
