This is in reply to your letter of August 22 concerning records of the Warren Commission.

There was no error in our letter to you of May 20, 1968. An examination of Portrait of the Assassin (New York: Simon and Schuster, 1965) by Gerald R. Ford and John R. Stiles (page 19) indicates that the quotations to which you refer relate to the executive session of the Commission of January 27 rather than January 22, 1964. The transcript for the session of January 27 has not been released or made available to anyone by the National Archives.

No transcript for the executive session of January 22, 1964, to which you refer has been found among the records of the Commission.
