I would like to get a copy of CD 718, listed in my copy of the list of basic source materials as "missing". This report and its attachment came from the FBI, which can with no difficulty replace your missing copy. I would like the entire document, please, with the attachment. It was originally withheld, and I would like to know under which guideline or by what request.

The list is illegible in the photocopy supplied me so I cannot make out the entire routing of this file. I would appreciate a transcription of the handwritten notes, which should be legible on your original.

This file may relate to a Mr. Owen or a Rev. (Henry) Owen, or both. I would like everything in the files on both, please. They should be in the other organizations and persons file, if they are mentioned likewise with the San Bruno church.

I would also like pages 467-9 of CD 203. I would like everything in the files on Jack T. Bowen or anyone who might be taken for him.

I again take this opportunity to respectfully remind you of certain unanswered previous correspondence. I think I am entitled to a meaningful response and I would hope you and the agency you head do not feel otherwise.
