I expect to be in Washington this coming morning, Wednesday
August 23, at that time I would like to examine Warren Commission Exhibits
100-4 and 100-78.

For this examination I would like to examine both the prints
and the FBI negatives from which they were made. It will not be necessary
to use the photo studio. The examination I plan can be made in the search
room.

Because I am not certain of my schedule, I hope you can arrange
to leave these exhibits for me in the search room early Wednesday morning.
I will then be able to look at them whenever I can get there.

Should I need any additional prints, I will leave an order with
the exhibits.

If there are other prints identical with these exhibits but larger
in size than the exhibits, I would appreciate it if you would also include
them.

It has been several months since I asked for the amount of the
charges made when Mr. Barnhart examined some of these and other exhibits and
returned photographic negatives. Would you please leave a record of this
charge for me? You have not yet responded. I am not asking for a breakdown,
just the total charge against my account that day.
