Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is in reply to your letters of October 17 and 18, 1969.

Enclosed are copies of a letter of Hovember 3, 1969, and the enclosures listed in the letter, which we have received from the Secret Service, as well as a copy of our letter of Hovember 12 acknowledging receivt of the letter and enclosures. As you will note, the enclosures to the letter from the Secret Service consist of electrostatic copies of same of the documents of which copies are requested in your letter of October 17 as well as the ribbon copy, five carbon copies, and a pencil draft of the Havy Certificate of Death for President Kennedy, all on the pink "HAVEED H" form.

As you probably know, copies of the letter of Dr. M. T. Jenkins of the University of Texas SouthAmpetern Medical School to the Administrator of Parkland Memorial Hospital, and the "Bunnary" signed by Dr. Kemp Clark, of which copies are among the enclosures to the letter of Hovember 3, 1969, from the Secret Service, are in Commission Document 87 (Control No. 561) and in certain mane and subject files of the Warren Commission. With this enception, neither the originals nor copies of the records of which you request copies in your two letters are known to be among the records of the Warren Commission. We will, however, make records of the Commission available to you in the Mational Archives in order that you can search for these and the many other records in which you are interested.

We have previously received the following materials relating to the assassignation of President Kennedy from the Secret Service: (1) one of the copies of the typed autopsy report and (2) the original papers reproduced in Commission Exhibit 397, of which copies have been furnished to you; and (3) the windshield of President Kennedy's car. We have not received any material relating to the assassination from the Department of the Havy.
