This is in reply to your letters of July 30 and 31, 1969.

We have nothing further to add to what is said in our letter of July 28 in reply to your request for the weighing of Commission Exhibit 399.

The copy of the authorization for the autopsy of President Kennedy has been in the autopsy file for President Kennedy ("John F. Kennedy 4-1 Autopsy"), since the records of the Warren Commission were received by the National Archives. We assume, as stated in our letter of July 29, that a copy of the authorization was furnished to you with the copies of the other papers in that file.

Copies of all papers relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy that were transferred to the National Archives by the Secret Service have been furnished to you.

The regulations of the General Services Administration on "Public Availability of Agency Records and Informational Materials" and "Public Use of Records, Donated Historical Materials, and Facilities in the National Archives and Records Service" are contained in Parts 105-60 and 105-61, respectively, of Title 41 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Copies of both parts are enclosed.
