Dear Dr. Rhoads,

In checking the copy of the JFK 4-1 file with which you supplied me, I find a page missing. This is the certification that appears in the Warren Commission hearings, 17H49. I stapled this file together on receipt, so I am positive it was not included in what was sent me.

I am writing to ask that, at your earliest convenience, you send one copy to me and one to Dr. John Nichols, Department of Pathology, University of Kansas Medical Center, Rainbow Blvd at 38th St., Kansas City, Kansas 66103. Please charge both copies to my account.

It has now been quite a long time since I asked that a copy of one of the two pictures of CE309 you took for me be sent Mr. Richard Bernabei. My repeated inquiries about this have received no response. I have been informed by Mr. Eckhoff's letter to Mr. Bernabei that you "have been unable to locate any record of having prepared a special photograph of the base of CE 309 for Mr. Weisberg".

This is simply incredible to me, as is the inordinate delay. I am without doubt that Mr. Johnson, who supervised the taking of these pictures, should be able to locate them promptly. However, to help you find what is in your own files, I enclose an electrostatic copy herein.

Once again I use this letter to remind you of the lack of response to previous letters I have written you.
