An electrostatic copy of my letter of 7/31/69, with the identical stamp and notations except under "register Number" it is NND0-26.

These indicate interesting things, among them being there is a date by which reply is due attached to each letter. I can only wonder what some of these would say. Sometimes we must find a way of looking at some of these that took two and more months. The general counsel (usually) is kept well informed. They have several files of my/all/selected correspondence on this archive, at least "official" and "reading"

Again I suggest you should read my file.
