It has been rather a longer time than can be accounted for an mornal delays from being busy.

I would also like copies of all focuments, whether or not in the files of the Warren Commission, about or from melvin Coffee, Alvin Besubosuf and Layton Martens, all connected with Ferrie. If any of these are withheld, I would also like their identifications and the reasons in each case. By "from" I include statements made by them, whether or not signed by them.

Theninordinate delays in responding to my requests are improper and are contrary to law. I do hope that whether or not you ordered it, you will see to it that this interference with "freedom of information" and my rights has is ended. I do not ask for special treatment, but I believe I am entitled to service no less accurate and no slower than that rendered others.
