Dear Dr. Nichols:

This is in reply to your letters of January 9 and February 15, 1967, ordering copies of Warren Commission exhibits. We sincerely regret the delay in answering your letters but the great public interest in the Warren Commission records has caused an unusual backlog of work.

We are preparing copies of the numbered exhibits of the Warren Commission and the Federal Bureau of Investigation listed in your letter of February 15. The following items in which you are interested are not in the relevant files of the Commission: (1) blank death certificate signed by Dr. Kemp Clark marked "A" on the attachment to your letter, (2) death certificate marked "B," (3) death certificate marked "C" (Nav. Med. N), (4) autopsy permission marked "D," and (5) burial-removal-transit permit. The records of the Commission do include, however, a Texas death certificate dated December 6, 1963, for President Kennedy, signed by Theran Ward, Justice of the Peace (Commission Document 87, Secret Service Control No. 59). Enclosed is an electrostatic copy of this certificate. We can furnish glossy prints of this document for \$1.75 if you want them, as there is a balance of 75 cents remaining from the amount you have remitted.
