There is a file of letters between the Marren Corrission and the Department of Justice having to do with an endorsement by Robert Kennedy of which I'd like a few pages, please. Nows are poor carbons, so I'd appreciate a copy made from the file in which the zerox is clearest.

One is dated June 4, 1964. It is a meno from Howard P. Willens to Mankin titled "Proposed Exphange of Letters", etc. and has Mankin's notation written after Willens' name. The poor copy if I have bears no file designation. The same is true of what appears to be one of the attachments, headed DAAFT, and accressed to Mobert Acamedy in the name of the Ohalman.

A third is dated June 12, 1964 and is a memo from Willens to matzenbach on "Proposed metter to the President's Commission", addressed to Katzenbach. The poor copy I have is identified as from GAI-Justice.

On a different subject there is a letter from J. Hegar moover to Hankin deted 9/23/72, by coly not indicating the file from which it came. Beginning, "On September 22, 1964, during a discussion by you with J.R.Malley", this latter concludes, "It would be appreciated if you would **Kelk** advise we the name of the appropriate authority to receive such investigation conducted by these furcau following the termination of the -religent's Commission."

Although the total is but four pages, I would appreciate it if you could rail those flat, as you sometimes do, so they will arrive without or asing. Long want to reproduce them. For the same reason, 1'd appreciate the clearest copies of these pages if they appear in more than one file. Thanks.
