### 'JFK' documents

Marina Oswald Porter, the widow of Lee Harvey Oswald, says Oliver Stone's film "JFK" put pressure on the U.S. government and led to today's scheduled release of CIA documents on the presidential assassination. Thousands of documents from the CIA, Warren Commission, investigative panels and congressional committees are scheduled to be released through the National Archives. Oswald's widow urged an Ontario conference on the assassination of President Kennedy on Saturday to keep questioning the case.
