This is in reply to your letter of August 2, 1975.

The copies of Warren Commission documents released in 1972-73, except the CIA documents already transmitted to you, are being sent to you separately. You are correct in assuming that the pages 63-73 of a transcript of an executive session of the Commission (item (9) (i) in our letter) are in the transcript of January 21, 1964. A letter of Lawrence R. Houston, General Counsel, CIA, to James B. Rhoads of December 22, 1972, also relates to the withholding of the records concerning Nosenko in item (9) and is denied to you under 5 U.S.C. 552 (b) (1). You will be informed by the CIA concerning the outcome of the review of this letter.
