by Burkley and the Secret Service Agents"

Under "Other Investigation there is 11/22/63 Ft. Worth Report of a Robert  
E (Last name unidentifiable), 3424 Haystack S.W. Albuquerque, NM license 2-80392,  
who said he was with FBI ("he had a gun", asked what time Pres. was coming,  
1955 two-toned Olds or Chevy.

Under XIV, "Photography Exhibits, list of key maps says "Police Officer  
J.D. Tippit shot and killed by OSWALD at about 1:17 p.m."  
Ruby's address, 223 S. Ewing.

Photo 7 described (447) as "view of box by assassin to steady rifle", taken  
by "press photographers" (454) actually, instead of showing what was called  
a depression caused by the rifle, in reality shows a much larger area

with the upper layer of paper of the cardboard gone, revealing the corrugated  
center section of the cardboard. In this picture the box is not on the window sill.  
53, Oswald mug shots, show long beard growth-had certainly not shaved that day.  
Right hand, full face shows that although hair is thinning, it can have an  
almost straight line, higher on his left side, with a slight downward few hairs  
note white directly above his nose/ Seems to be more than one day's beard. Picture  
dated 11/23/63, which is odd
