He said he thought that since we are withholding the papers, we might as well give all possible reasons for withholding, although one of them might be withdrawn on consideration of an appeal. He thought that was preferable to producing a reason later on consideration of an appeal. As Mr. Harford says, the inter-agency memorandums may appear in evidence (over)

annoyance of the Kennedy family
and the Department of Justice if
Weisberg approaches them for additional
related material, I think it best
to withhold our material, which is
attached, in order to get a policy
decision from the Department through
its Freedom of Information Committee
as to whether this material should
be released. This can be done if
Weisberg appeals the denial.
