Enclosed is a copy of a letter of May 24 from Mr. Harold Weisberg in which he requests copies of the transmittal letter from the Secret Service and, by implication, of the "memorandum of transfer" of the materials relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy.

We have not yet received the list of withheld documents to which Mr. Weisberg refers in his letter, unless he is referring to one of the long letters among the four which we sent you with a memorandum dated April 7, 1970. This would be as confusing as his reference to a "print and negative of the picture duplicating mine that you took of the base of CE 399 for Dr Nichols". He has definitely said that he would send a list of withheld documents concerning which he wants to appeal. We are informing him in a reply to three other recent letters that we have not received his list.
