Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is to notify you that the Secret Service has transferred to the National Archives the original Government copy of the "memorandum of transfer" of the materials relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy. Like the electrostatic copy of this document which we informed you we had in our letter of August 19, 1970, the original document is withheld from research under the terms of 5 U.S.C. 552, subsection (b) (6), as part of "medical files and similar files, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" of the family of the late President Kennedy.
