This is in reply to your letter of October 12, 1972.

Enclosed are copies of the Secret Service transmittal letters dated March 6 and December 14, 1970, for an electrostatic copy and the original of the Government copy of the "memorandum of transfer" which are in our custody. As you know, the Kennedy family's copy of the memorandum is also held by the National Archives and Records Service for safekeeping, but it is still the property of the Kennedy family. It was used by the panel of doctors who reviewed the material relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy for Attorney General Ramsey Clark. No copy of the memorandum has been used by any other researcher.
