In our letter of August 19, 1970, we told Mr. Meisberg that the Secret Service transmittal letter of March 6, 1970, was withheld from research under 5 U.S.C. 552, subsection (b) (5), as an inter-agency letter because of reforences in the letter to confidential data. An alternate draft reply is enclosed which could be used if it is decided that the Secret Service transmittal letters should be withheld.
