Interview of HOMOPONC ALCARAZ ARAGON was conducted at Mexico, D. F., on 1/22/64 by SA ROLAND E. TRENT. This individual was identified through VON FEACOCK, Acting Director, Friends Service/Center, Mexico, D. F., who, on 1/20/64, advised that ANO/ALGCZAR, the alleged graduate student at the National University of Mexico who planned to study further in France, was undoubtedly HONOBONO ALCARAZ ARAGON, who had frequented the Friends Service Center in the past.

FEACOCK also advised on 1/20/64 that GUSTAVO ALCARAZ a brother of HOMOBONO ALCARAZ, was at the Friends Service Center on 1/20/64 and GUSTAVO ALCARAZ promised to locate his brother and have him come to the American Embassy, Mexico, D. F., which was accomplished on 1/22/64.
