THE COMMISSION NOTES AND INQUIRES AS FOLLOWS:

SA INCEMEX: FOUR SIXTY THREE REPORT LISTS NINETY PEOPLE ENTERING MEXICO AT NUEVO LAREDO SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST AND TWENTY FOUR PEOPLE DEPARTING FROM THERE OCTOBER THREE SIXTY THREE. WHILE LISTS PURPORTEDLY COMPLETE, OSWALD'S NAME DOES NOT APPEAR ON EITHER OF THEM. WHY ARE THESE LISTS IN FACT COMPLETE EXCEPT FOR ABSENCE OF OSWALD'S NAME? IF BOTH LISTS COMPLETE EXCEPT FOR OSWALD'S NAME, HOW CAN DISPARITY IN NUMBER OF PERSONS ON TWO LISTS BE EXPLAINED?

OSWALD'S MEXICAN TOURIST CARD SHOWS HE ENTERED MEXICO AT NUEVO LAREDO SEPTEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST AND DEPARTED FROM THERE OCTOBER THREE LAST. METHOD OF TRAVEL NOT INDICATED. DL REPORT DECEMBER EIGHT SIXTY THREE ON PAGE THREE ONE SIX INDICATES MEXICAN IMMIGRATION RECORDS SHOW OSWALD DEPARTED NUEVO LAREDO OCTOBER THREE LAST QUOTE METHOD OF TRAVEL, AUTOMOBILE, DESTINATION NEW ORLEANS

RECORDS SHOWING OSWALD LEFT BY AUTOMOBILE? WAS OSWALD ACTUALLY IN  
AUTOMOBILE WHEN HE CROSSED BORDER OR DOES RECORD MERELY SIGNIFY  
THAT HE STATED HIS INTENTION TO TRAVEL TO NEW ORLEANS BY AUTOMOBILE  
AFTER HE CROSSED BORDER? FROM INFO AVAILABLE CAN WE DETERMINE WHO  
MIGHT HAVE BEEN IN ANY AUTOMOBILE WITH OSWALD AT TIME HE CROSSED  
BORDER OR THEREAFTER?

DL ADVISE AS TO BASIS OF COMMENTS IN FIRST PARAGRAPH, PAGE  
THREE ONE SIX OF YOUR DECEMBER EIGHT SIXTY THREE REPORT WITH PARTICULAR  
REFERENCE TO OSWALD'S DESTINATION OF NEW ORLEANS AND USE OF CAR.

SA RECHECK MEXICAN IMMIGRATION RECORDS NUEVO LAREDO TO INSURE  
LISTS IN YOUR DECEMBER FOUR SIXTY THREE REPORT WERE ACCURATELY  
RECORDED. RESPOND TO COMMISSION'S INQUIRIES CONCERNING THESE LISTS.  
IF THEY WERE COMPLETELY REPORTED EXCEPT FOR ABSENCE OF OSWALD'S  
NAME, SO STATE. IF REPORTED LISTS WERE COMPLETE AND REPLY TO QUESTION  
CONCERNING DISPARITY IN NUMBER OF PERSONS ON LISTS IS THAT THE  
RECORDS SITAK FOR THEMSELVES, SO STATE. REPORT IN COMPLETE DETAIL  
WHAT THE MEXICAN IMMIGRATION RECORDS AT NUEVO LAREDO SHOW RE  
OSWALD'S ENTRANCE INTO AND EXIT FROM MEXICO, AND REPLY TO  
COMMISSION'S INQUIRIES CONCERNING AUTOMOBILE. HANDLE AT ONCE  
REPLYING IN FORM TO DISSEMINATE. LEGAT, MEXICO CITY, BEING  
REQUESTED TO RECHECK ALL AVAILABLE IMMIGRATION RECORDS AT MEXICO CITY.
