The following persons bear a close physical resemblance to and appear to have been mistaken for Lee Harvey Oswald:

- Robert Ahler, (FBI file DL100-10461 and DL44-1639),
- Lee Harris, (FBI file SA89-67), and
- Dudley Lee Ferrell, 10150 San Lorenzo, Dallas, Texas, (FBI file 89-43).

In order to help resolve positive identifications of Oswald in improbable places, this Commission would appreciate your providing three copies of appropriate photographs of the above individuals together with a personal history of each including a general account of their activities and whereabouts between September 26, 1963 and January 1, 1964, a detailed statement of their activities on November 21 and 22, 1963, and inquiry into their acquaintanceship with Lee Harvey Oswald, Jack Ruby, employees or friends of Jack Ruby, business enterprises of Jack Ruby, and persons engaged in pro-Castro or anti-Castro activities. The foregoing pictures and reports will be needed by us no later than March 27, 1964.
