Dear Bill,

I want to thank you for your interest and effort, for sending Rod and for his willingness to work extraordinary hours while he was here. All day and half or more of the night!

He left with a box of copies and a sample of the pictures. If after he gets back there he recalls other new evidence he forgot to ask for, let me know and I'll send copies.

My own view of the present situation is that it is conducive to the whole business coming apart now. And that the new evidence you now have an advance crack at is what can do it. The forum can be political, like Congress, or judicial, from continuing litigation.

Rod has some of the material I got from the current suit in addition to the paraffin tests that I think justify the headline, "New Scientific Evidence Proves Oswald Innocent." (Or Suppressed Evidence.) I'm putting the rest together as fast as I can. My guess is that I have written more than half of the addition to the long book. It will all be available.

Where the copies Rod has are not clear it is because that is the nature of the originals. I used lots of copying paper making the best possible copies. In order to make some legible I had to experiment and over-expose. Knowing this would be the case I had my machine serviced before the copying, a complete overhaul.

No bill is included for this. I do enclose the bill for the commercial xeroxing and for the copy-machine paper. For my records they are, respectively, \$55.73 and \$43.53.

Your interest is in being able to report "new." All this is that. But it does not in any case stand alone. It all has considerable to overwhelming backstopping for the "old" much of which is now forgotten. The combination and the changed situation, I do believe, now makes possible what has been impossible for a decade. I hope your people will see it this way.
