

## IFK Was Killed by a Russian Agent

Michael Eddowes, a noted British investigative writer, won wide acclaim in Europe by proving that Timothy Evans, an Englishman who was mistakenty hanged far the murder of his baby doughter, was innocent of the crime. Evens was given a posthumous pardon after Eddowes proved beyond a doubt that the real killer was mass murderer John Regineld Hallidoy Christie. In his new book, "November 22 — How They Killed Kannedy," Eddowest presents shocking new evidence that a Russian KGB ogent, posing as Lee Harvey Ozwald, assassinated President Kennedy. A spokesmen for Sen, Richard Schweiker (R.-Pa.), who heads a Senete subcommittee investigating the JFK cassassination, told The ENQUIR-ER: "Because of Mr. Eddowest previous record in the Timothy Evans case, the panel is taking a very careful and serious look of the information he has supplied on Lee Harvey Ozwald and the assassination of President Kannedy."

President John F. Kennedy was slain by a Russian KGB agent
posing as Lee Harvey Oswald, says British author Michael Eddowes after a 12-year investigation of the crime of the century.

Eddowes, 72, one of England's foremost investigative writers, has published a new book unraveling what he describes as a devious Soviet plot, masterminded by Nikita Khrushchev, to murder an American President.

"I am convinced from my investigations that the man who killed JFK was a KGB assassin who hoped to return to Russia after the killing," Eddowes told The ENQUIRER in a lengthy interview.

Here are some of Eddowes' shocking findings, after an exhaustive,

costly investigation that has taken him all over the U.S. in his search for

"The real Lee Harvey Oswald, according to his U.S. Marine Corps records, was 5' 11" — two inches taller than the man shot by Jack Ruby in Dallas.

"The real Oswald had three scars on his upper left arm, two of them the result of a shooting accident when he was in the Marines.

"But the impostor who died in Dal-land and in the wrong places," Eddowes said.

"When he was 6, the real Oswald underwent a mastoidectomy — an ope-eration for removal of a small piece of bone from behind the left ear. It left a one-inch scar — but the man who shot JFK had no such scar.

arm are all recorded in his Marine
Corps records. In the autopsy report,
the arm scars are noted — but the
one-inch scar behind the left ear is
not mentioned.



AUTOPSY REPORT describes Lee Harvey Oswald as "5 foot, 9 inch" while his U.S. Marine Corps record (see extract at bottom left of page) lists his height as 71 inches (5 foot, 11 inches). This is one of the discrepancies that proves it was not Oswald who assassinated President Kennedy, says noted British investigator.

"The KGB found one of their officers who bore a strong resemblance to Oswald. This man was given special training at a spy school in Minsk. He was indoctrinated with Oswald's complete background, taught to speak with Oswald's Texas accent, and trained to kill with rifle and handgun. "Oswald was kept allive to brief the impostor — but was later killed in Russia after the assassination of JFK," Eddowes asserted. New evidence uncovered by The ENQUIRER reveals that Lee Harvey Oswald could not have killed President John F. Kennedy.

At the very moment JFK was shot, Oswald and a friend — George de Mohrenschildt — were standing on a downtown Dallas street watching the motorcade pass, de Mohrenschildt told a hospital roommate last December.

December.

De Mohrenschildt said Oswald ran from the scene and he never saw Oswald again. He also said that Oswald was once offered money by a CIA agent to kill Kennedy — but rejected the offer.

De Mohrenschildt made these disclosures to roommate Clifford Wilson in Dallas — but before the House assassinations committee got a chance to hear them, de Mohrenschildt was found shot

to death.

The ENQUIRER has also uncovered another startling aspect of the Kennedy assassination case.

Top secret government documents — kept locked away until only days ago — reveal that Lee Harvey Oswald worked for the CIA.

These documents, now in The EN-QUIRER's possession, prove Oswald was on the CIA's payroll three years before JFK's assassination — a fact that top CIA officials have vigorously denied,

even under oath.

De Mohrenschildt's death came on
March 29 in Manalapan, Fla. A local
coroner's inquest ruled it a suicide. Last year de Mohrenschildt, a Dallas geolo-gist, had tried to kill himself four times,

gist, had treed to thi himsel four times, and had spent the last weeks of the year in Dallas' Parkland Hospital.

At the hospital, de Mohrenschildt became friendly with Wilson, a manual laborer ... and over a period of 11 days in December, de Mohrenschildt confided to Wilson that Oswald could

"He said to me: 'I know damn well Oswald didn't kill Kennedy — because Oswald and I were together at the time,' "Wilson told The ENQUIRER in an exclusive interview.









#### At Least 21 People Linked to the Assassination Have Died Mysteriously

When former Cuban president Carlos Prio Socarras sent a fatal bullet crashing into his chest April 5, he became the latest name added to an astonishingly long list of people who died mys-teriously — and often violently — after being link-ed to the assassination of John F. Kennedy.

Since that fateful day more than 13 years ago, at least 21 men and women who knew something or some-body connected with JFK's murder have died under strange circumstances. In alevery case they died either by murder or suicide.

The macabre list of deaths grew bigger when Prio committed suicide. His death has brought renewed interest into an FBI document that had been shelved with thousands of atthemptions. of other assassination-related files in the National Archives.

Ten days after the assassina-tion, FBI agent Daniel Doyle wrote a report quoting a reli-able FBI informant that Prio was actually a one-time busi-ness associate of Jack Ruby, the nightclub owner who killed assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.

The report said that Ruby once purchased a share in a Havana casino in which Prio was the principal owner. In the mid-1950s both Ruby, known as Jack Rubenstein, and Prio were active in arranging flights of weapons to the Castro guerrillas in Cuba while Prio was financing the supply of arms to pro-Castro forces.
