I have given you the list of documents the H. S. A. people said they examined.

The list of documents (18, 11b, etc.) are items which the H. S. A. people want to examine further at their offices. They said they would have a Dr. Tordello (?) call or write requesting these items. Mr. Eisenberg wants you to get a receipt for anything that goes over there.

They said they are primarily interested in names. If you can think of names, e. g., in Mexico, which they may not have come across in the material we gave them, you might supply such names to them. They claim they have information on names which the C. I. A. does not have.
