The Dixie Klans are associated both with Robert Shelton's United Klans and with James Leavelle's National Knights of the KKK; are more numerous than most local KKK groups; the Browns control one strong klavern in Andalusia, Ala., a few small ones in the northwest corner of Georgia, but their main strength is in eastern Tennessee where they have perhaps as many as 2000 or 3000 supporters.
