# Baltimore Denies Permit For Right-Wing Rallies

BALTIMORE, Aug. 6 (AP) — Two right-wing groups were denied permission yesterday to hold a series of rallies in Riverside and Patterson parks.

Charles A. Young Jr., the superintendent of city parks, said he rejected the petitions of the National States Rights Party and the Fighting American Nationalists.

Their proposed programs, Young said, would present "a clear and present danger to peace and good order" in the city within the meaning of park rules.

Young said Charles H. Luthardt, leader of the Fighting American Nationalists, had failed to comply with regulations by refusing to submit the names of proposed speakers.

Luthardt had sought permission for a 2 p.m. meeting today in Patterson Park and proposed several alternate

dates if the first was not possible.

The National States Rights Party, which became involved in a near riot at Patterson Park two years ago, wanted to conduct eight rallies beginning Thursday at Patterson and Riverside Parks.
