Body Found In Car Trunk Is Identified

BALTIMORE, June 3 (AP) — The body of a man identified as Joseph J. Carroll, former secretary of the National States Rights Party in Maryland, was discovered in an automobile trunk today.

Police said the 25-year-old Carroll had been shot at least 10 to 12 times in prison following a conviction for inciting to three times.

Carroll had been sentenced to prison during a series of anti-Negro rallies at Patterson Park in 1966. Racial disturbances followed the last rally.

Carroll's mother, who reported him missing Monday morning, said she last saw him when he rushed out of their Lutherville home Saturday morning.
