Dear Mr. Weisberg:

In your letter of July 1, 1977 you question certain entries that were incorporated in the report forwarded you by this Agency on June 26. You also express concern over DIA's inability to locate material relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy.

The following information should answer your questions and clarify the position of DIA concerning the subject. An inquiry to the Naval Investigative Service resulted in the following data:

- a. The series of numbers following ADD appearing on the bottom of the first page of the report which includes "5/4/64" indicates two additional copies of the document were reproduced on May 4, 1964.
- b. Navy considers the record as part of the Oswald dossier. Thus the citation "Harvey Lee Oswald" is signified for filing purposes. The initials "FF" indicates this is a "Finished File."

DIA assumed the management of all Defense Attache affairs on July 1, 1965. At that time we became primarily responsible for the review of all attache oriented reports, regardless of date. Though DIA does not actually possess or maintain jurisdiction over these reports or references thereto, this task remains an inherent function of the Agency. This may explain in part our negative replies to your earlier requests for JFK assassination material. Additionally, the primary mission of DIA is to manage and provide support to the foreign, not domestic, military intelligence activities of the Department of Defense. This lends additional credence to the assertion that the records of DIA were and remain properly void on the subject of your interest.

We trust this satisfactorily answers your questions and adequately explains the position of DIA in this matter.
