This is not precisely what the earlier report says of Brady. It does not say he might be able to identify the people in the pictures but knows Cubans, which is not the same thing.

Also, he did not "move" to the Philippines. He was deported after his second morals-law violation with a young boy. If the T series of informants is federal, the informant knew better. The FBI also should have known better, for it is part of the deporting department of the government.
