Dear Mr. Wilson:

I hope things are going well for you. I sent a copy of my last letter to Harold Weisberg. He wrote back and wanted me to forward a copy to you.

As you can imagine, he has some doubt about the material you found in James Earl Ray's car. Since Harold is without a doubt the foremost expert on Ray in the world, I think you will find his letter interesting.

MURKIN is the murder of King file. Harold tell me that he has written about 120,000 words on the Gerald Posner book. As I believe I told you before, he sold quite a few books of Case Open, his answer to Posner's Case Closed. Even though no major paper would review his book, which shows Posner to be a fraud. Posner mixes truth and fiction together so well that only a subject matter expert can tell them apart.

I hate to be paranoid, but I am sure Harold is right that there has been some interference in his house. We have four documented cases, with physical evidence that his home has been broken into. We suspect the FBI, as nothing of value to normal people has been taken. We also believe that when Gerald Posner did research there, he may have taken some documents, even though he had free use to the copier.

Posner seems to get help from "official " sources. For example, when Yuri Nosenko defected to the US from the KGB, he told the CIA in 1964 that he handled Oswald's file in Russia. So he was kept in a cage in a basement of a CIA safe house for about 2 years. Then, he was given hush money and kept on as a CIA consultant. We would all like to interview him, but only Posner has ever been allowed to.
