I wish to advise you that 17 pages of material are pew available for release and include, with one exception, the material Mr. Weisborg made specific request for during a recent discussion be had in your presence with representatives of the FBI. The one exception is the data concerning spectrographic examination of metal amears on a section of a curbstone. We are still in the process of compiling this data and will advisa you concerning this as soon as it is possible to do so.

The following is a statement regarding fees we are authorised to charge in accordance with Department of Justice regulations, currently published in the Federal Register. The regulations authorize a charge at the rate of \$1.00 per each one quarter hour apent by clerical personnel, in excess of the first quarter hour, in searching for and producing a requested 🖰 record. Where a search cannot be performed by elerical personnel, charges for the search may be made at a rate of \$2.00 per each one quarter hour spent in excess of the first quarter hour.
