According to the letter of BRINGUIER, OSWALD distributed such handbills on Canal Street, New Orleans, on August 9, 1963. Also, according to the letter of BRINGUIER, OSWALD had distributed such handbills in the name of A. J. HIDELL. In addition, according to the letter of BRINGUIER, OSWALD had distributed pamphlets entitled, "The Crime Against Cuba," by CORLISS LAMONT, printed by "Basic Pamphlets," Box 42, Cathedral Station, New York City.

Also, in his letter to LANUSA, BRINGUIER had enclosed an Autostat of a blank application for membership in the FPCC, New Orleans. According to LANUSA, a DRE member at New Orleans, not identical with BRINGUIER, had obtained the application from OSWALD preparatory to an attempt by the DRE to infiltrate the FPCC.

Text of the FPCC leaflet which BRINGUIER had sent to LANUSA by letter dated November 25, 1963, is as follows:

"HANDS OFF CUBA!

"Join the Fair Play for Cuba Committee

"New Orleans Charter Member Branch

"Free Literature, Lectures

"Location:

"L. H. OSWALD 4907 Magazine New Orleans, La.

"EVERYONE WELCOME!"

Text of an Autostat copy of the FPCC membership application which BRINGUIER had mailed to LANUSA at Miami, the original of which was reportedly obtained from OSWALD by a DRE member, is as follows:

"To: The Fair Play for Cuba Committee New Orleans, La.

" I wish to join the Committee. Enclosed is my Unitiation Fee of \$1.00 and dues are \$1.00 a month.
