He did not remember me from Capitol Hill days. We spoke briefly, and he said, as had Wicker and Salisbury, he did not know what he or the TIMES could do. He did suggest, however, that I talk to a Mr. Gilroy on the TIMES staff who writes about books. It was Ochs's idea that Gilroy might be interested in a news story about the inability to get a book on this subject published. He also thought I might talk to the AClu and other such people on the question of freedom of speech and publication.
