Dear Mr. Salisbury,

I will be going to New York the morning of 3/27, leaving the late afternoon of the next day and, on my way home, returning sometime Saturday. I tell you this in the event you'd like to learn more of the results of my unknown work. There are two limited editions of books and several incomplete books, plus an enormous amount of documentation in my possession the use of which I have not finally fixed upon.

With regard to the autopsy alone, I have solid proof of perjury and its subornation, that the wounds were other than described and not where they were said to have been. The film records both photographs and X-rays, are tainted. Both are incomplete, some of both are destroyed. I have some of the documents all copies of which were thought destroyed. I also have proof of the destruction of evidence, where, when and by whom.

You also may have some interest in New Orleans. I think I can answer your questions.

Should you want a backgrounding, perhaps our schedules can coincide. My one stipulation would be preservation of confidence.
