Dear Fred,

I see, to have forced the government to add Zap335-343 to the available slides in the Archives. I wish I could get and send you prints but I cannot. However, I do want you and the others to know that these are now available. You may recall my handling of this in IR and its appendix.

I did not have time for the kind of careful analysis required, but I can give you these quick impressions:

The look of horror on Jackie's face at 2343 is unforgettable.

Some of these shots show JFK's neck back and head back almost at right angles to the lens. I saw no blood or any other indication of a wound, no traces on the top of the collar, which is clearly visible in some frames. I cannot explain this except in terms of a later shot or delayed bleeding, and I cannot justify either of these.

My apologies for not thinking of it sooner. I have asked Dick Sprague to send you the serial shots taken by Jarrold about 3 pm 11/22/63. Should have thought of it much sooner. I am anxiously looking forward to what you can do with that! If you do not get within reasonable time, let me know and I'll remind him or seek another source for you.
